Our internet speed is in the 30-40mbps range, which is good for such a rural location and should be more than adequate for browsing etc. However it won't handle lots of people trying to stream high bandwidth content. Please be considerate to your fellow campers when using the internet connection.

Dogs: To be kept on leads or tethered whilst in the camping field. Dogs can be let off lead in the field beyond the camping field. Please pick up after your dog, using the bins provided.

Vehicles: No vehicle movements between 10pm and 7am, if you need to use your vehicle between these hours then please leave them on the hard standing at the end of the drive before you enter the camping field. Please note there is limited space available.
Strictly **5 MPH** everywhere on site

Greener Camping Club

Being certificated by the Greener Camping Club is what allows us to share our land with you. When you booked to stay with us you were automatically enrolled as a member, and your membership fee was either included in your pitch fee or paid for separately depending on the length of your stay. Your membership card will be emailed to the email address you provided when booking. Your membership is valid from January to December and can be used at any of the other GCC sites, within the year

The aims of the Greener Camping Club are to promote more environmentally friendly camping and as part of that your membership fee helps towards environmental projects, such as habitat creation and a carbon offset scheme which means that for every member signed up a tree is planted.

Waste and recycling: Recycling for plastic, glass and metal in bins next to the toilet block
Other general landfill waste should be bagged and placed in the bin
Food waste: There is a large blue food waste caddy in the wash-up area
Please help us and the planet by recycling it is something we insist you do.

Ice Blocks: There is a freezer in the wash-up area. You are welcome to use the blocks marked FD whilst your own blocks are freezing. We recommend marking your own blocks to avoid any misunderstandings!

If placing food in the freezer, please ensure it is bagged together and not left loose and that you remove anything stored on departure.

Phone charging: We have lockable solar charging lockers for your use. Please think carefully whether you need to charge phones as it uses the same power that lights the toilet block! Please look after the keys they are security keys and we do not have copies.

The farmyard: We ask that all campers keep out of the farmyard, unless directed to use for access, out of respect to our cottage guests. Please use the entrance through the top field.

Solar power: Our toilet block lighting and phone charging is all solar powered. There should be ample power if phone charging is kept within reasonable levels. Please let us know if there is no lighting at any time as we do have a spare battery for emergencies.

Toilet block:

Hot water: Runs on an instant water heater and should provide ample water, if it doesn't run hot after a few seconds, then turn off the tap / shower and start again to fire the boiler.

Toilets: We have a septic tank system on site, so please no wet wipes or sanitary products down the loo, please use the bags provided and place in the bins.

Campfires and BBQs: No Fires or BBQs on the grass please, we have fire pits,, that you can borrow. There are also stones by the toilet block for disposable BBQs.
Logs are for sale at £6.50/net or 3 nets for £18 - just ask or call and we will bring them to you.
